LLANELLI GETS NEW DIGITAL 'First Impression' PROJECT

People in Llanelli can increase their jobhunting skills at a new digital facility opening soon at Jobforce Wales in Cowell Street, Llanelli, following a grant from Communities @ One.

Free digital access will be available on 12 laptops along with digital cameras and a scanner to produce individual digital C.V's and improve presentation skills.

A £13,000 grant for the project comes from Communities @ One, funded jointly by the Welsh Assembly Government and the European Union Objective 1 and 2 programmes, to provide access to new technology for people in Communities First areas, delivered through the Wales Co-operative Centre and Jobforce Wales.

The project addresses the demand for free digital facilities and support, identified in consultation with residents in 2004.

Marc Davies, Communities @ One Broker says, "We hope this will remove some of the barriers that stop people from getting involved and let people see what the benefits to them are".
